TRAINING PROGRAM

Oakland County Michigan Works!, in partnership with Oakland Community College, Ascension Southfield, St. Joseph Mercy Oakland and Mocerri Senior Living, is pleased to offer this new, innovative advanced training program to eligible residents.

- Cohort runs from Jan. 13 – March 6, 2025
- Combination of 130 hours of classroom, lab and clinical training.
- Classroom instruction at OCC's Southfield campus: Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, 5:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m.
- Clinical training at Ascension, St. Joseph Mercy Oakland or Mocerri Senior Living, 7:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
- Students are also required to complete a one-day Basic Life Support (BLS) training session
- Students must purchase scrubs (white top, grey bottom) and wear closed-toed shoes
- Upon completion of the program, students earn OCC Completion Certificate, BLS Red Cross Certificate and qualify for the Michigan State Certified Nurse Aide Exam and Patient Care Technician board exam of their choosing

- Vital signs
- Charting
- EKG Testing and Monitoring
- Catheter care and removal
- Sample collection
- Wound care
- Assistance with administering non-controlled medication
- Bathing, feeding and toileting
