Metro Detroit's healthcare industry is growing, with plentiful career opportunities. Sterile processing technicians are in high demand across Oakland County and play a critical role in hospitals and other medical facilities.

This entry-level position, which pays up to \$20 an hour, can lead to a number of advanced career pathways with greater pay and responsibilities, such as a surgical technologist or clinical laboratory technician.

Oakland County Michigan Works! and Oakland Community College offer a special training program for sterile processing technicians. We partner with several hospitals in the county that provide required clinical rotations. Students receive a certificate of program completion and the opportunity to take the Certification Board for Sterile Processing & Distribution (CBSPD).
